



ADVANCED FISHING CAMP



July 12-16, 2010

Please read the following information. Each day we will be leaving Twin Creeks (J.J. Biello Park) to participant in activities. Children will be transported in CRPA vehicles. If you have any questions or conflicts please let the staff know. We have a very exciting week planned and we look forward to working with your children.

This week is our newest addition to fishing camp for the more advanced fisherman and more technical fisheries. New tactics will be taught using soft plastics and hard baits and understanding water structure and entomology. The vast majority of the week will be spent fishing for large mouth bass in our private waters.

We will be practicing the **Catch & Release** method when necessary however any fish that are kept due to "bleeding" will be cleaned and put on ice each day and cooked during our fish fry on Friday. We will be taking pictures each day and burning those to a CD for you and your child to remember the week. Those CD's will be mailed at the completion of camp.

- ✓ Parents are REQUIRED to sign their child in & out each day. The CRPA vans must leave promptly each morning at 9:15 AM in order to maximize fishing time. Please do not be late.
- ✓ Please send a sack lunch, snack and drinks daily. **We do not recommend soft drinks.**
- ✓ CRPA will be hosting a FISH FRY on Friday for the campers to enjoy!
- ✓ Please send hat, polarized sunglasses, and sun screen with your child.
- ✓ Wear Tennis Shoes EVERY DAY. DO NOT wear any open toe shoes! No Exceptions!
- ✓ **Campers must provide their own fishing rod/reel for this camp. Tackle is optional.**
- ✓ CRPA will be providing all the necessary tackle and bait each day.
- ✓ You may provide a personal floatation device for your child if you feel necessary. We will be fishing from the bank on all trips, except for when getting in the water at Tammen Park. The water depths are shallow enough throughout the park to wade the river by foot. Water temperatures are cold.
